



Parental fees from 1 September 2018 for child day-care facilities and services

Parents must pay a monthly fee, known as the parental fee, to have their child looked after as part of a day-care facility or service.

This mandatory fee must start being paid as soon as a child is admitted into a day-care facility or service.

Crèche and daily-care service

The following fees are charged for care at crèches and, for children under 3, within daily-care services and in mixed-age groups.

Basis of the parental fees

The parental fees apply from 1 September 2018, based on the “State Capital Dresden regulations on charging parental fees” enacted by the City Council on 15 May 2014. The parental fees are determined by the age of the child at the start of the respective month.

What does “1st child”, “2nd child” etc. mean?

Every child who attends a day-care facility or service with a sibling is counted as such. E.g. If the first and second child are looked after simultaneously at a day-care facility or by a day carer, both are counted. Child-inclusion status can be requested for children being looked after by parents living apart (alternating model).

Discount or waiver for financial reasons

Low-income families may pay discounted fees or no fees at all. This requires lodging an application at the Fees Office of the Office for Child Day-care Services. The final decision takes into account the specific income situation and special living circumstances.

Reduced parental fee for solo parents

Anyone who lives with their child predominantly as a solo parent, and is therefore bound to look after and raise one or more children without the help of others, can request a reduction in the parental fee from the Fees Office of the Office for Child Day-care Services.

Discounted lunch costs at day-care facilities and schools

Parents with a verified entitlement to receive benefits for their child (Arbeitslosengeld II unemployment allowance, housing allowance, children allowance, SGB-XII social welfare, entitlement under the Asylum Seekers Benefits Act) may request an allowance for their children's lunch costs.
