Student traineeships at the City Administration

The City of Dresden offers placements for students working in their field while studying. There are many places you can work, whether you join the Geodata and Land Registry Office while on technical courses or studying architecture, or the Youth Affairs Office when studying social work.

Advantages of working at the City Administration while studying:

- gain valuable practical experience that helps you launch your career (you get a letter of reference)
- make important connections
- gain insights into working conditions and access to internal job postings
- the employer and students can get to know one another and see whether they are a good match
- pay in line with the collective bargaining agreement for the public service (TVöD), from €15 an hour

All applicants will be treated equally. People with a foreign passport can apply for a work placement at the City Administration while studying, and are more than welcome here.

Requirements:

- from eight to twenty hours of work a week (no more or less; full-time work available on request in breaks between semesters)
- students may not work while taking a semester off from their studies
- students enrolled on a full-time course at a University of Applied Sciences or higher education institute/university
- written notification of the overall result of their final examination has not been received
