Objectives:

82 % of the overall budget is related to the "convergence" objective.

This applies to regions within the EU whose GDP per capita is below 75 % of the EU average. The main objectives are the structural modernization of the economy and the creation of jobs.

Since 2000, the Free State of Saxony has been allocated various subsididies by the structural funds of the EU.

The regional district of Dresden, which is one out of three within Saxony and roughly covers the Eastern part of Saxony, has been categorized as a maximum-funding region with respect to the 2007 to 2013 period.

The European funding rate amounts to 75 %, while the municipal cofinancing rate is 25 %.

This contribution concerns the specific ERDF funding component related to Sustainable **Urban Redevelopment** (corresponding to about 9 % of the overall ERDF funding for Saxony).
